

CSR Approved Project 2025-26

Pursuant to the approval of the Board of Directors under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013, the Company had approved a total CSR budget of up to ₹15 lakhs for the Financial Year 2025–26, which includes an amount of ₹2.75 lakhs in excess of the statutory requirement. In alignment with Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Company’s CSR Policy, the CSR expenditure during the year was directed towards projects focusing on promoting healthcare, sanitation, education, livelihood support, and welfare of under-served communities, with priority given to local areas and regions surrounding the Company’s operations.

The Board approved CSR initiatives undertaken through eligible implementing agencies, which primarily included:

- Promotion of education through provision of classroom infrastructure such as benches and digital learning aids;
- Support towards healthcare initiatives including organization of health camps and medical assistance;
- Provision of basic amenities and welfare support to old age homes and community institutions;
- Contributions towards hygiene and sanitation initiatives under recognized social programs; and
- Other community development activities aligned with the objectives specified under Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.

Further, the Board also approved the set-off of excess CSR expenditure incurred during the year over and above the statutory requirement, in accordance with applicable provisions, to be adjusted against CSR obligations of the immediately succeeding three financial years.
